We are a global leader in the manufacture of intelligent water management solutions to support water sensitive urban design with products that have a dual purpose of protecting people from water, and water from people. We offer an extensive portfolio of stormwater, building drainage systems, cable enclosures, access covers and other products for niche applications. These products are installed in internal and external residential, urban, commercial, industrial, and civil engineering applications.

Our products are manufactured to be mechanically strong and UV stable with high thermal and corrosion resistance. They are tested to perform to the strictest performance standards to ensure they last for the design life of the project without premature replacement. Where possible, we keep our supply chain local to ensure transport distances from cradle to gate are short, minimising the carbon footprint associated with transportation.



As an Australian manufacturer and supplier, we are committed to sustainable operations through reducing waste and pollution, improving product sustainability, increasing energy efficiency, using clean energy where practical, recycling wherever possible, and working with environmentally responsible partners. In 2023, we completed a greenhouse gas assessment across our Australian operations to measure and benchmark our environmental impact and establish key reporting metrics.

We are currently undertaking a comprehensive Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) of our core products to:

- inform future product design and sourcing to ensure a further reduction of environmental impacts
- support the development of two Environmental Product Declarations (EPDs), scheduled for release in Quarter 3, 2026.

The LCA project commenced with a detailed carbon footprint assessment of product components across key product lines manufactured in Australia for supply to the construction industries of Australia, New Zealand, and the South Pacific. All assessments and supporting documentation have been prepared by an independent sustainability consultant and verified by a third party, ensuring accuracy, transparency, and credibility throughout the process.
